This funding will be used to

- Ensure Prep students make a successful transition to schooling and demonstrate at least a years worth of growth utilising Early Start – Literacy as the tool for the measurement and tracking of student development
- Increase the percentage of upper primary students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English from 30% in 2017 to 60% in 2018.

Our initiatives include

- The engagement of a Prep-1 Teacher 2 days/week to deliver a robust, explicit **Prep Program** reflective of the Australian Curriculum and additional time for the teaching principal to work with upper primary students on these days
- Engage additional Teacher Aide time to support continued implementation of **Rapid Reading Program** to assist with Reading Skills, Whole School Literacy Development and Feedback Strategies.
